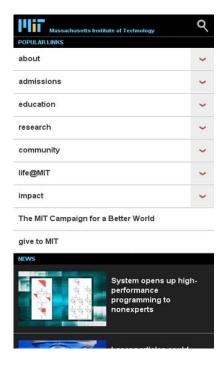

Prioritize visible content
